



You will need:
 50g butter
 100g dark chocolate,
 broken into small pieces
 2.5tbsp golden syrup
 80g cornflakes

Large saucepan
 Spoon
 Cupcake cases

Easter Nests

Lots of birds live in the family tree.
 Here's a recipe to make your very
 own tasty bird nests.

What to do:

1. Place the butter and the chocolate pieces in a large saucepan with the golden syrup.
2. Slowly melt over a low heat and keep stirring.
3. When the mixture is completely melted, turn off the heat.
4. Add the cornflakes to the saucepan and stir well.
5. When the cornflakes are well covered in chocolate, place some small paper cupcake cases on a tray.
6. Fill each case with a heaped tablespoon of the mixture.
7. You can decorate your nests with chocolate eggs, or any other kind of sweet you like.
8. Put in the fridge to set.

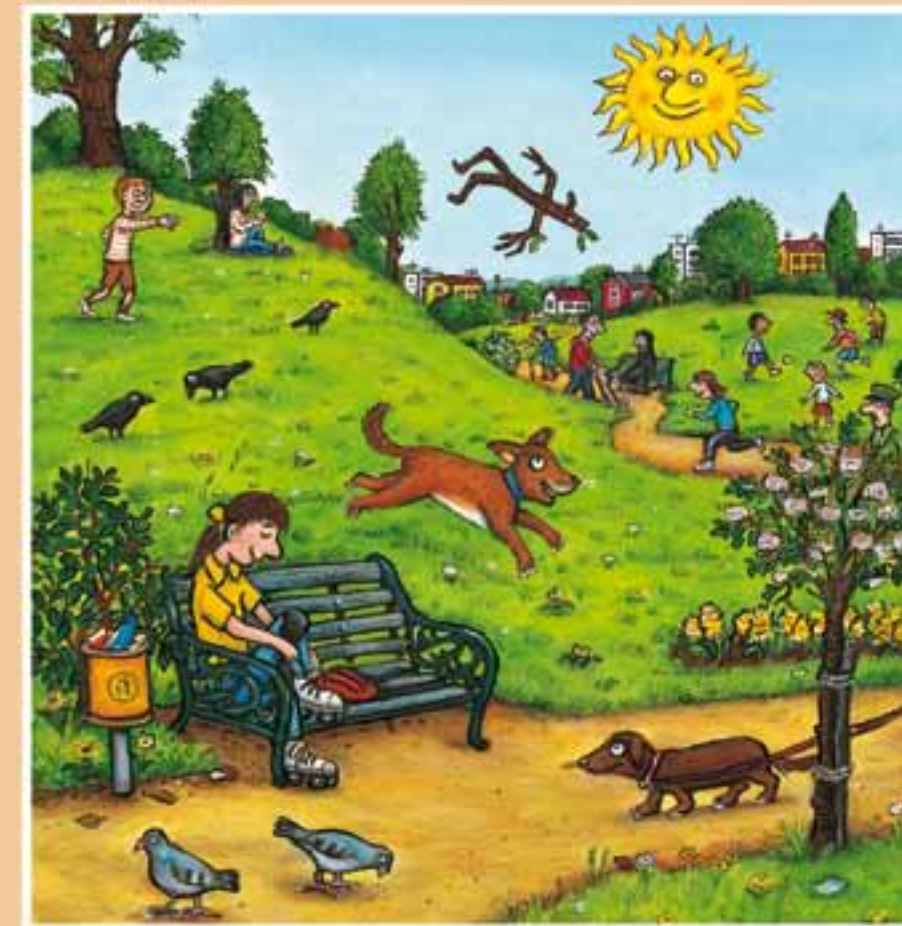
