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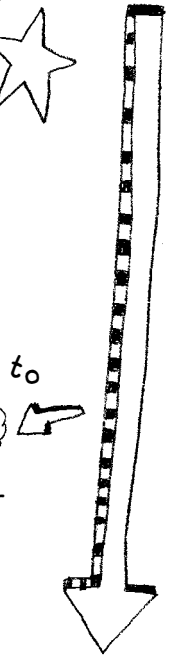


THIS STAR PUPIL BADGE

his **BADGE** ever since he put it on.

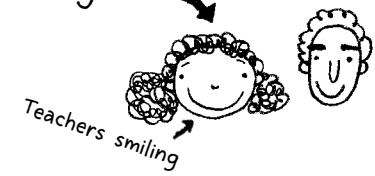


AMY's had a **STAR PUPIL BADGE** before but

The badges this term I  EXCELLENT.

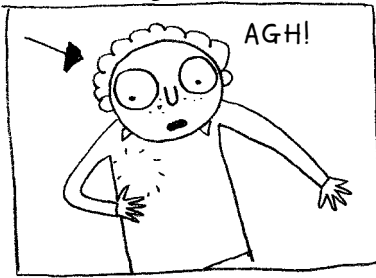
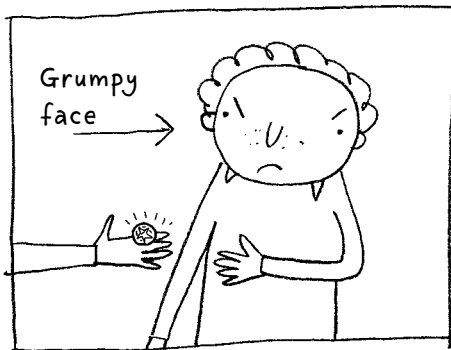
So, just for a change, I'm going to get



ALL my  homework done on time too. 

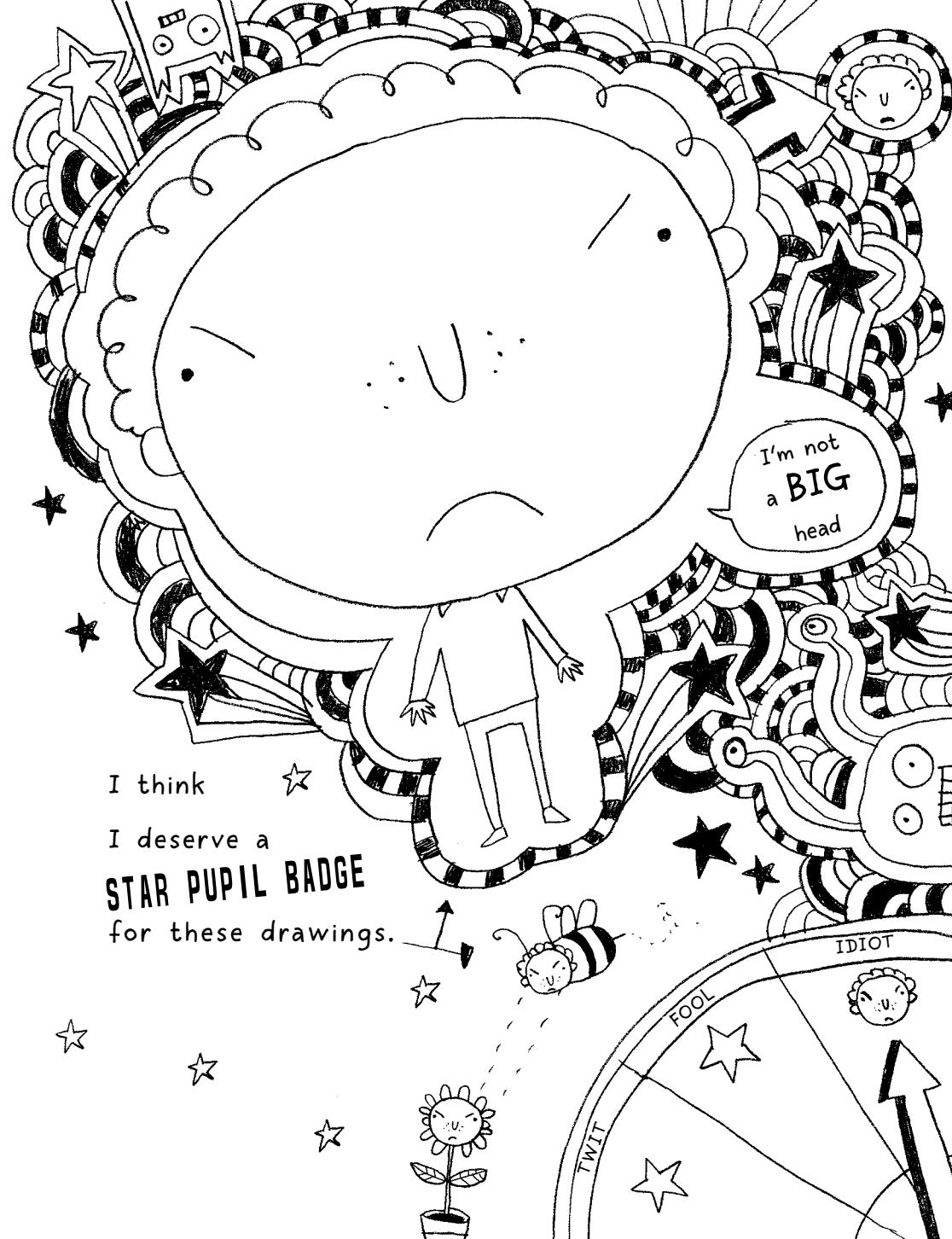
I REALLY want a  **BADGE**.
