tasty cakes.

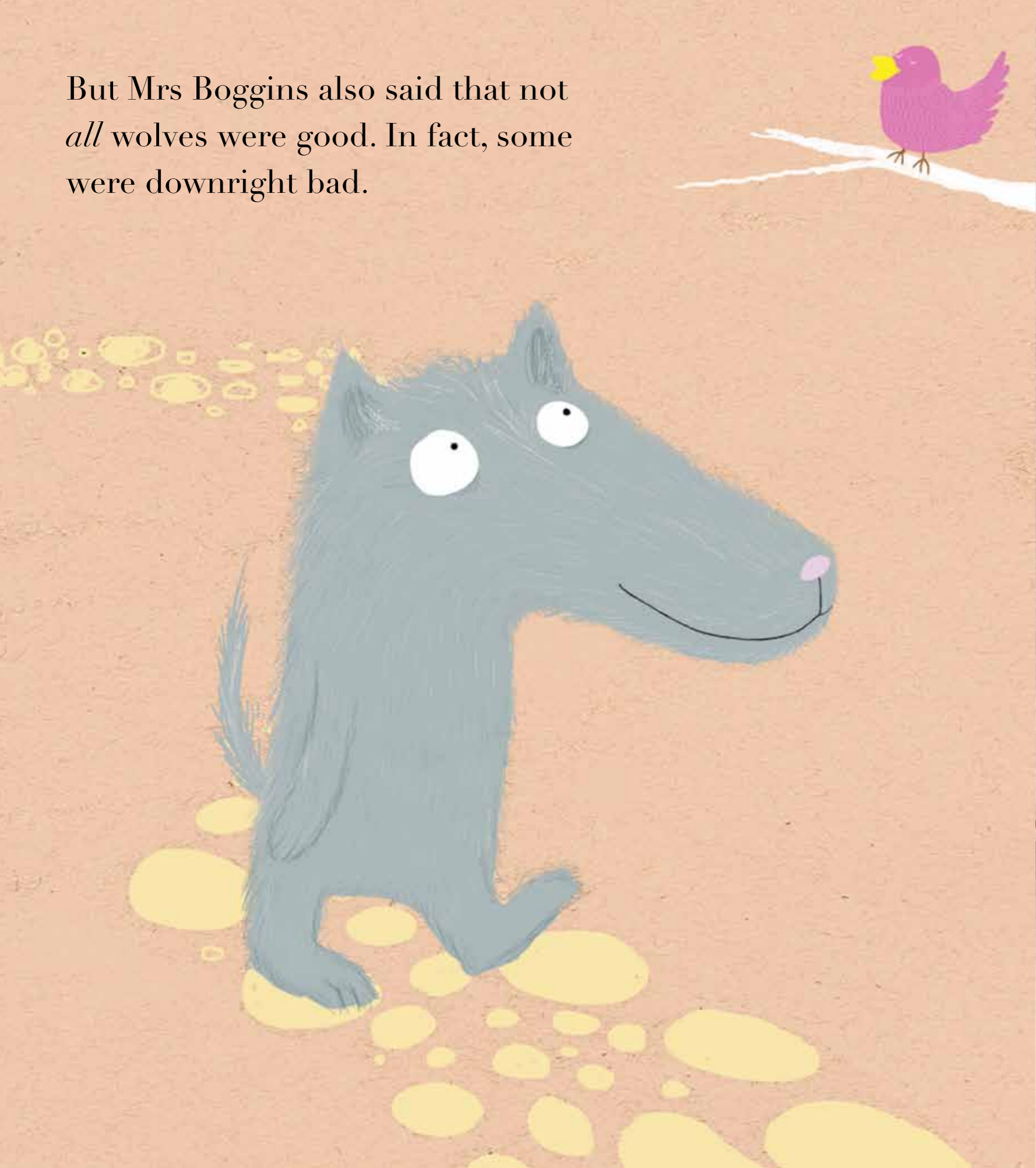


He ate up all
