JASON'S DREAM . . .

Within the awesome heights of the Himalayas, the truth was revealed to a loving couple. The teachings came from the Radiant Kingdom. As soon as Lee saw her he felt as though he had always known her, and that he could see deep into her soul. Lee started talking to the young woman and discovered that her name was Jean, but there was no need to woo her, their deep attraction was mutual and instant.

Lee and Jean fell in love with each other, and almost immediately started to plan a life together. They were both very interested in esoteric ideas, and both wanted to understand the real meaning of life. Very soon they had agreed to save up enough money to travel to the Himalayas together in search of mystical teachings.

When they finally set out on their adventure, they knew in their hearts that something very significant was about to happen to them. On the seventh day of a guided trek in the Himalayas, they felt a strong pull to wander away from their group and very soon they could no longer see the group or their guide. They were alone together in the awesome mountains.
